PROGRAMS FOR GIFTED STUDENTS

Acceptable programs for gifted students provide educational opportunities that enhance their special abilities. It is the intent of the Charlottesville School Board to develop and promote an appropriately differentiated educational program for gifted students. The Division shall use multiple criteria for the identification of gifted students, as prescribed by the Virginia Board of Education. An annual report regarding the Gifted Education Program shall be submitted to the Virginia Department of Education as prescribed by the Virginia Board of Education.

The School Board shall establish a local advisory committee to advise in the development of gifted education services and to support the program in the community. Annually, the committee shall review the gifted education program and determine the extent to which the goals established for the program were achieved. The recommendations of the committee shall be provided in writing to the superintendent and to the School Board. The program shall be in compliance with the Code of Virginia and the Standards of Quality.
